SCOPE OF WORK

Meat Products of India Ltd. has a modern bovine plant, swine plant, and rendering plant with the capacity to slaughter and process 200 animals per shift, with exclusive facilities including a weighbridge, lairage, slaughter, processing, and storage.

The company proposes to offer complete utilization of the rendering plant to outside parties for a period of six (6) months.

The rate quoted shall be inclusive of all costs for processing bovine and swine bones separately, including all incidental expenses and applicable statutory levies.

The scope of work includes the supply of fresh bovine and swine bones to the company by the contractor.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. The rendering plant may be used for bone processing. The contractor may utilize facilities such as the weighbridge, ETP, generator, etc. MPI will share the boiler facilities of the factory. All bones procured by the contractor shall be properly tagged and stocked as per the directions of MPI. Actual cost of the electricity and Fuel shall be deducted from the contractor.
2. Skilled labour and additional facilities required for bone processing shall be provided by MPI and will be billable to the contractor. The contractor may engage labour and supervisors to oversee the process, with prior permission from MPI, at the contractor's expense. The contractor shall submit the names and details of such staff in advance to MPI. All contractor personnel shall possess valid identity cards.

3. The contractor shall be permitted to use the plant for fifteen (15) days in a month. A minimum of 5,000 kg of bones per day shall be processed initially and which can be increased to a maximum of 7,000 kg per day from the second month onwards. Quantities in excess of the above shall not be permitted by the company.
4. MPI shall be at liberty to undertake processing for a third party in the rendering plant if the contractor fails to achieve the target quantity mentioned in Clause 3 within six (6) months of the agreement.
5. Procurement of raw materials for the rendering plant and sale of finished products such as bone meal, tallow, and sediments shall be the responsibility of the contractor. All by-products generated during processing, including tallow and sediments, shall be removed from the premises before the next operation.
6. The contractor may carry out minor alterations to the existing plant to achieve production targets, subject to prior approval from MPI. The cost of such alterations shall be borne by the contractor. The contractor may also install additional machinery for smooth operation, provided it does not cause any hindrance or damage to existing facilities or machinery.
7. The contractor may use the trolleys, baskets, and pallets already available at the plant. The sale of finished products shall be the sole responsibility of the contractor.
8. The rendering schedule shall be intimated to MPI at least one (1) week in advance. The bones supplied shall be fresh and in good condition. Only fresh bones shall be permitted for rendering. The contractor shall strictly adhere to the decisions of MPI in this regard.
9. The contractor may undertake job work for clients. MPI shall have no direct association with, or liability for, such activities.
10. The contractor shall not use the name of MPI for the distribution or sale of products processed elsewhere. Any violation shall invite strict legal action.
11. The contractor shall comply with all rules and regulations prevailing in MPI.

12. MPI reserves the right to use the facility for its own production requirements as and when required.
13. The contractor shall be responsible for the payment of all statutory levies related to the services provided.
14. The provisions of the Stores Purchase Manual of the Government of Kerala and the CVC guidelines shall form part of this tender, as Meat Products of India Ltd. falls under their purview.
15. The Managing Director of MPI reserves the right to make necessary alterations to the terms and conditions, as deemed necessary, at any point during the tender period on mutually agreed terms.
16. Based on the quantity of raw material processed, the contractor shall settle the service charges every Saturday.
17. The contract shall be valid for a period of six (6) months from the date of the agreement.
18. In the event of any breakdown, all unprocessed bones shall be removed from the company premises by the contractor without claiming any additional cost.
19. All periodic and breakdown maintenance shall be carried out by the contractor. The cost of all spare parts shall be borne by the contractor.
20. The annual maintenance cost of the 2 TPH boiler shall be borne by the contractor on a pro-rata basis.
21. For availing the facility of generator backup, the cost of HSD shall be payable by the contractor on an actual basis.
22. The operational expenses of the ETP, electricity charges of the plant, and other related expenses shall be borne by the contractor on an actual basis.

- 1.2 **The qualification and experience of the firm shall be submitted along with the bid and qualification of the bid will be evaluated based on the compliance of the same.**
- 1.3 **The Tender shall be submitted in the prescribed format.**
- 1.4 **List of technical staff, their qualification /experience and details of in – house facilities may be mentioned.**
- 1.5 **The qualification and experience of the firm shall be submitted along with the bid and qualification of the bid will be evaluated based on the compliance of the same.**

A). Documents Comprising Bid:

Pre-Qualification or Technical proposal shall contain the copies of the following documents which every bidder has to submit.

1. The signed Tender document shall be submitted in the prescribed format.
2. Contractors/Agencies that have sufficient valid experience of 3 years in operation and maintenance of utilization of the rendering plant of similar nature will be eligible to submit offer against this tender. Experience of last 3 years with supporting documents should be attached.

Fixed price: Prices quoted by the Bidder shall be fixed during the bidder's performance of the contract and not subject to variation on any account. A bid submitted with an adjustable/ variable price quotation will be treated as non-responsive and rejected.

2.0 GENERAL CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT

2.1 Validity of offer

The offer shall be valid for six months from the date of opening.

2.2 EMD

Contractor/Agency shall submit an EMD as specified in the Tender Notice as Demand Draft from any Scheduled Bank drawn in favour of MANAGING DIRECTOR, MEAT PRODUCTS OF INDIA Ltd, payable at KOOTHATTUKULAM. The EMD of unsuccessful tenderers will be re-funded after issuing the work order to the eligible bidder.

2.3 Rates

The rates quoted shall be for raw material such as 1 kg bone of bovine and 1 kg bone of swine separately including all the GST/taxes applicable to the above said work. **Statutory obligations like ESI, Provident Fund, Insurance, Medical expense / claim due to any accidents etc., of the personnel employed by the Contractor/Agency shall be met by the Contractor, and MPI shall not be held liable for any such defaults.**

TDS shall be deducted from the Contractor's bills as per rules.

2.4 Security Deposit

The successful bidder has to remit Security Deposit for an amount equal to the 5% of the awarded value equivalent (subject to minimum of Rs.25,00,000(Twenty Five Lakhs) by way of DD from any Scheduled Bank in favour of MPI Ltd, Koothattukulam or account transfer within 7 days of receipt of the work order. The Security Deposit will be refunded after satisfactory completion of 6 months.

2.5 Payment

The Contractor/Agency has to settle the payment in every week. All the statutory taxes and duties will be deducted from each bill.

2.6 Tools and testing equipment

During the emergency situation all the necessary Spares, Materials, and Consumables required for maintenance and commissioning work should be arranged by the contractor including the Annual Maintenance of 2TPH BOILER. All tools, tackles, top up & recovery machines, testing equipment and accessories as required for the emergency maintenance shall also be provided by Contractor at his own cost. Travel expenses should also met by the contractor.

2.7 Details of the technicians

List of technical staff, their qualification /experience and details of in – house facilities should be submitted along with the tender. The service provided by each person engaged by the Contractor/Agency must be satisfactory to MPI.

2.8 Assignment

The rights and obligations arising out of this agreement shall not be assigned or transferred to a third party without prior written consent of either party.

2.9 Completion of work

On completion of the work, the Contractor/Agency shall handover all the materials belongings to MPI representative and the Contractor shall remove all materials belonging to him including the workforce without any delay.

2.10 Force Majeure

If performance by either party of its duties and obligation under this agreement is prevented or delayed by circumstances of force majeure including, but not limited to fire, flood, earthquakes, strike, war, riots, insurrection, any action undertaken or restriction imposed by authority of any Government agency or court, shortage of equipment or raw materials or any other act beyond its reasonable control, the time within which the affected party must perform shall be delayed for a period under such circumstances to a maximum of 120 days during which the parties shall use alternate methods, but after which period either party shall have the right to terminate the agreement. Determination of this agreement shall not relieve either party from the payment of the sum or performance of other duties and obligations, which may be owing to the other, as a result of the operation of this agreement prior to such termination.

2.11 Termination

Notwithstanding anything contained herein, either party to this agreement shall have the right to terminate this contract by giving the other party 30 days notice in writing.

If the service of the Contractor/ Agency is found to be not satisfactory, the contract will be terminated with one months notice and the Contractor/Agency will not be eligible for any compensation on this account.

2.13 Settlement of Disputes

Any disputes with respect to this contract shall be settled amicably as far as possible and disputes that could not be amicably settled, shall be left to the decision of a sole Arbitrator appointed by the Managing Director, MPI. The Arbitration proceedings will be held as per the Arbitration Act then in force.

2.14 Jurisdiction

Any dispute connected with this contract shall fall within the jurisdiction of Courts at Ernakulam.

3.0 SPECIFICATION

- a. The contract period will be extended only on the basis of mutually agreed terms and conditions.
- b. Not more than one tender shall be submitted by a Contractor. More than one concern in which an individual is interested as Proprietor and/or Partner shall not submit tender against this notice. If anybody does so, all such tenders shall be liable to be rejected.
- c. Contractors are advised to inspect and examine the site and all the rendering plant equipments and satisfy themselves before submitting tenders. They themselves shall obtain all necessary information as to risks, contingencies and other circumstances, which may influence or

affect their tender. A tenderer shall be deemed to have full knowledge of the machineries and site conditions, whether he inspects it or not and no extra charges consequent on any misunderstanding or otherwise shall be allowed.

- d. Submission of a tender by a Contractor/Agency implies that he has read this notice and all other contract documents and has made himself aware of the scope of work. After that, he has to sign the Annexure A (also the part of the agreement).
- e. The tender shall be accepted through online portal. Tender shall be submitted in sealed covers along with EMD, sub scribing the name of work and the address of the Contractor, addressed to Managing Director, MPI. **All tender papers should be sealed and signed.**
- f. Notification of award of contract will be made in writing to the successful Contractor/Agency by the Managing Director, MPI. The contract will normally be awarded to qualified and responsive Bidder offering the highest evaluated bid. The Managing Director, MPI shall be the sole judge in this regard. **The Managing Director, reserves the right to accept or reject any of the tenders without assigning any reason whatsoever.**
- g. A responsive bidder is one who has the required experience & capability and who submits priced tender with EMD and accepts all terms and conditions of the specifications and tender documents without any modifications.
- h. A modification is one, which affects in any way the quality, quantity and period of service or which limits in any way the responsibilities or liabilities of the Contractor/Agency or any right of MPI as specified in tender documents. Any modification in the terms and conditions of the tender, which is not acceptable to MPI, shall be treated as a major modification.
